Union club donates \$10,000 to local library

The Rotary Club of Union has donated \$10,000 to the Carnegie Library to assure continued children's programming throughout the year, and especially during the summer months. The donation will fund Summer Reading special events, the purchase of books and audiobooks for the youngest readers through teens, as well as art supplies and materials that make the library the place for kids to be during the summer.

Rotary dollars will also be used to promote literacy programs at the library for the children of Union County once school begins in the fall.
